Release your reign and the goodness of your kingdom so that the illness which covers the world may be contained; that healing and hope might be experienced by many.

Lord, we ask, seek, and knock because you are our God and our times are in your hands. Increase our faith, strengthen our hearts, and give us courage to love extravagantly and boldly. Help us to manifest your love to a hurting world, and teach us to pray, Lord.
